Hence table holders can set up from 07:00 on the day.

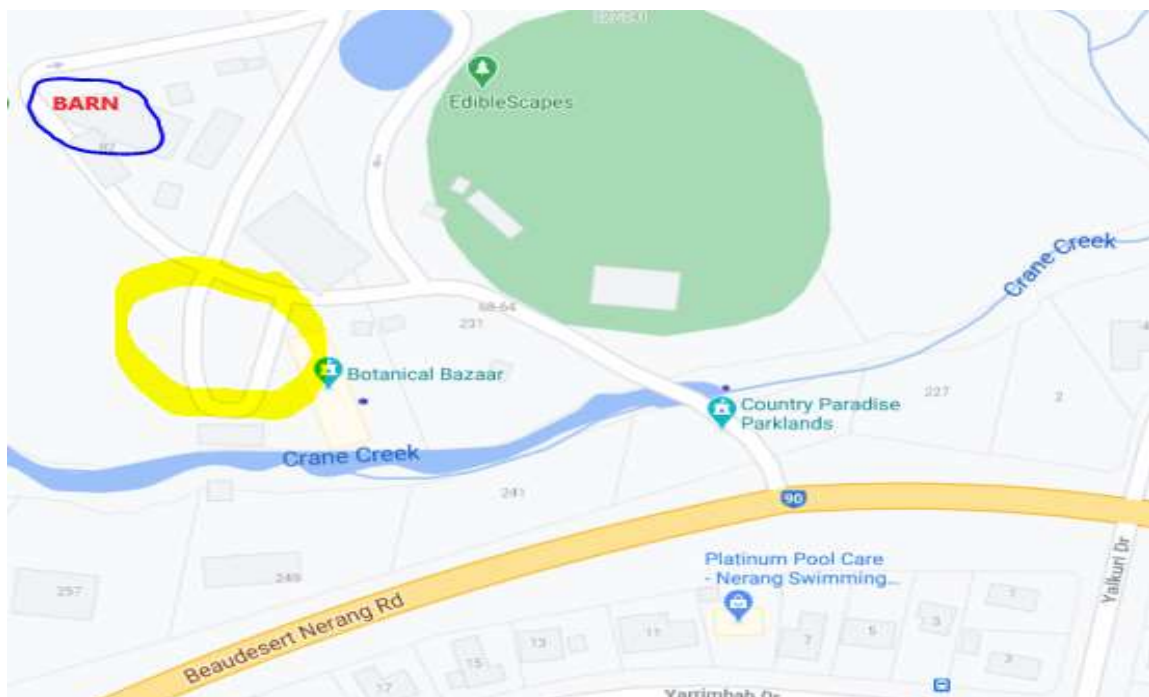
General Public will be allowed into the BARN area from 08:30.

147.225MHz (91.5) tone (Springbrook - Wide Area Network) WAN will be monitored on site for those having issues in locating the Venue.

Entry / off loading / parking.

- Depends on where you are coming from the North take exit 69 on the M1
- From the South Take Exit 71 or 73 on M1
- Once you have entered Country Paradise Venue
- You can drive straight up to the BARN as per the map. Off load at your table and then park your car in the carparks within the yellow highlight area on the map.
- Any issues there will be enough GCARS Members on site to ask.

- There will be a Coffee Van on site as well Bacon and Egg muffin / Sausages /Onions and Bread along with cold Soft Drinks via GCARS BBQ.
- As this is a new venue for GCARS for the HAMFEST there might be some teething issues so bear with us, so we can sort them out if they do come up.
- For those that are requiring power (this is included in your Table cost) GCARS will supply an extension lead and splitter board. If you need anything else then please bring.
